Medical Board keeping close watch on Bonney

The Medical Board of Queensland is continuing to monitor the activities of Dr Clem Bonney after a charge of child pornography laid against him was mentioned in Brisbane Magistrates' Court earlier today.

The Medical Board immediately sought undertakings from Dr Bonney that he would not consult, assess, examine or treat any person under the age of 18 after becoming aware of the charges in December 2008.

The Medical Board will closely monitor adherence to these undertakings by regularly examining Dr Bonney's clinical records, appointment diaries, log books and Medicare records.

Chairperson of the Medical Board of Queensland Dr Mary Cohn said the Board will take all necessary measures to protect the well-being of patients.

Dr Bonney is scheduled to reappear in court in March at which time the Board will reassess Dr Bonney's registration in light of the Court's decision.
